Minutes from Quarterly General Meeting held on Tuesday 8th November 2016

Treasurers Report - no notes

De Fib – Adam showed the action group the defibrillator which has now been installed in the village on 17th November by Alex Quartnton.

Members agreed the telephone box requires some TLC. Adam agreed to jetwash the inside and outside. Backboard may need painting. Sue advised she would look at previous minutes to find out who painted the box back in 2011.

All agreed to re-visit painting of the box in Spring/Summer 2017.

Training to be held in the church by the Heartbeat Trust and local ambulance/first responder. Wednesday 25th January put forward, Adam to propose date and location with Heartbeat Community.

Adam to make flyer to be hand delivered with the Scackleton/Hovingham newsletter asking residents to confirm either via email or paper form in the box provided in the telephone box as numbers need to be confirmed for the training session.

Manual checks on the defibrillator need to be carried out for insurance purposes. A manual rota was suggested; to be reviewed.

Each member of the action group (per household) will get 5 tickets each to sell.

Cynthia took notes as to who would be supplying what food on the evening. The evening would include a raffle and a quiz.

Wendy proposed a “white party” where everyone wears all white and there are white decorations. Paul offered to DJ and set up the lighting. To primarily raise money for the Scackleton Action Group, we would charge for tickets to include supper and a dance. Wendy put forward the idea of paying for a table of 10 and provide your own alcohol.
