## Hovingham Share Shed



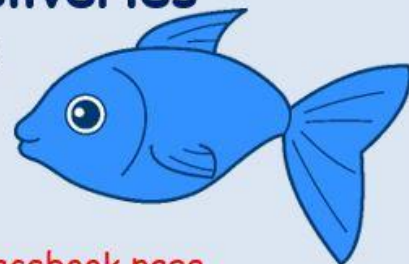
