**Grass cutting.**

- Correspondence received from NYCC. From April 2015 it will no longer cut urban grass or contribute to the cutting of urban grass. Hovingham with Scackleton currently receives £1553 towards grass cutting. There will be a reduction in the areas to be cut in rural locations yet to be determined.

### Action Group Report

- The playground to purchase extra equipment with the money from Open Spaces Fund

### Cemetery Gates Maintenance and Wall Repairs

- Councillors R. Matthews and R. Wainwright had met and adjusted the gate.
- Mr D. Lumley has started the pointing of the wall.

### Church Clock

- Proposed Parish Council contribution £400.  
Subject to a full service being carried out Councillor I. Battersby proposed, Councillor R. Wainwright seconded and it was agreed to contribute £400. Councillor M. Wilson abstained.

### Flood Plan Review.

- The current plan has been reviewed and, subject to any further information, is deemed to be satisfactory.

### Parking at Playground

- The residents of Brinkburn Barn had expressed concern about the number of vehicles parked both sides of the road and in the turning circle at the playground and cemetery. It was agreed to place notices asking drivers to park sensibly and see how it works. It is important that the emergency services and undertakers have access to the area.

### Pasture Lane Development

- RDC has received the full amount of Open Spaces monies. It is being claimed by the groups identified to improve facilities.

### Rail Painting.

- Two quotations had been received. The clerk was asked to contact the person submitting the lower of the two to confirm the areas for which the quotation had been made.

### Village Hall Car Park Maintenance

- Councillor M. Wilson sprayed the weeds in the car park.
- The Chairman was hopeful of getting a quotation for maintaining the car park and the flower tubs in Hovingham and Scackleton. This could then be included in the budget.
- Councillor P. Chapman proposed forming a group representing the Bowls Club, Village Hall, Market Group, Action Group and Parish Council to consider how to develop the area left after the Bowls Club hut was removed. This was agreed.
