#### **Apologies**

Apologies were received from Councillor R. Matthews and North Yorkshire County Councillor Mrs C. Wood.

#### **REPORT FROM DISTRICT COUNCILLOR R. WAINWRIGHT.**

- Sports and Leisure Management Ltd, brand name 'Everyone Active', to take charge of the three leisure facilities on 1<sup>st</sup> October in partnership with the RDC.
- Applications for drilling rigs inside AONB, based on historic evidence would invite comments on site, sight and noise. Other consultees would be Highways and Environment Agency. An Environmental Impact Assessment needs to be made before a planning application is submitted.
- Clerk to ask Councillor Mrs C. Wood to ask NYCC to put pressure on the government to explain the criteria of 'exceptional circumstances' when allowing extraction within AONB. Also contact our MP, Anne McIntosh.

###### **Dogs.**

Areas of concern a) Excrement b) Dogs not under control c) Dogs in the playground.

- It was agreed to publish an article in the Newsletter outlining the issues.
- Those concerned about individual dogs should contact the RDC Dog Warden or the Police. (details on noticeboards or from Parish Clerk) Reporting matters to the Police could result in the offending animal being destroyed.

###### Grass cutting.

- Areas to be cut or funded by NYCC are currently unknown.
- The current level, for both villages, can be maintained in 2015.
- Agreed to see if someone would be willing to cut the bottom green, Hovingham to the same standard as the top green.

###### **Highways Church Street Repairs**

- Agreed the work on Church Street, Hovingham, was unsatisfactory.
- Agreed to invite Mr R. Marr to meet Councillors on site to discuss the problems.

###### Police

- Regular visits to the market are welcomed.
- PC P. Fenwick is now a member of the Action Response Team.

###### **TESLA Donation.**

- Councillor Mrs M. Bell wished to register her objection to the acceptance of the donation for

the villages.

### HOVINGHAM.

#### Action Group Report (attached)

- Mr D. Richardson to liaise with the school about the memorial plaque and art work for the tunnels.

### Buses -New Contract from 3<sup>rd</sup> November

- NYCC served notice on Stephenson's of Easingwold. As from 3<sup>rd</sup> November there would be a minimal service, 2 hourly to Malton no service to Helmsley.
- Currently Stephenson's of Easingwold is the only applicant to provide the service.
- Ryedale Community Transport may be interested in providing a Friday service to Helmsley Market; this is being investigated and will require funding

### Maintenance Cemetery Gates and Wall Repairs. Rail Painting

- Weather permitting painting due to begin week beginning 15<sup>th</sup> September
- Wall repairs under way and further length to be completed shortly.

### Church Clock Parish Council

- £2,500 had been raised for the service of the clock.
- Additional funds could be found for painting/new clock face.

### 5 Hall Farm Cottages and 7, Hall Farm Cottages

- JRHT notified the Parish Council that the sale of both properties is going through.

### Notice Board – Hovingham

- Clerk to contact Mr A. Thackray for estimate.

### Parking

- Suggested that residents near the playground purchase cones to protect access to their properties.
- There was no consensus for notices on Park Street to redirect motorists to the village hall car park.

### Pasture Lane Development and Status of Funding.

- The provision of a public walkway from the site to the public footpath is of concern. Councillor R. Wainwright to speak to Mr G. Housden.
- Details of the status of the Open Spaces Fund was provided to the Parish Council.

### Pasture Lane Sign.

- This has been repaired.

### Village Hall Car Park Maintenance.

- Former site of Bowls Club Hut has been resurfaced.
- Satellite dish removed.
- Shed moved next to mini-recycling centre.
- Hedge to be cut back soon.
- Outside electric socket installed.

The Playground has separate accounts as part of the Action Group and is funded by a market café and help from the Market Group.
