Cemetery Charges and Regulations

(Revised May 2017)

1. Internment: (Excluding labour, grave digging etc)
 - a) Body or cremated remains of a still-born child or a child not over one month old £20
 - b) Body, or cremated remains, of a child over one month and not over twelve years old £35
 - c) Body of a person over the age of twelve years old £100
 - d) Cremated remains of a person over the age of twelve years old £55
2. Exclusive rights of burial in Earthen Grave for a period not exceeding ninety-nine years from the date of purchase
 - a) Grave 9ft by 4ft (2.27m by 1.22m) £100
 - b) Grave 18 inches square (0.45m) for the internment of remains only £55
 - c) Grave 9ft by 9ft (2.27m by 2.27m) £175

Graves may be double-depth to accommodate two bodies or cremated remains; the above charges still apply.
3. Headstone £45
To add an additional name £25
4. The aforesaid fees apply only where the person interred or to be interred or in respect of, whom exclusive right of burial has deed purchase, is or was immediately before death an inhabitant of Hovingham or Scackleton or in the case of a still-born child where one of the parents is such and inhabitant in all other cases the fees will be double those specified above.
5. Headstones should not exceed 2ft by 18in (60cm by 45cm) in size and wording on headstones should be appropriate. Curb stones must not be used.
6. All enquiries relating to the cemetery should, in the first instance, be addressed to the Clerk.
