Joseph Rowntree Housing Trust request to extend the 'local connection' area.

- Councillors agreed that extending the local connection area in this case should not set a precedent.
- Each case to be reviewed as it arises and decided on its own merits.
- It was noted that purchasers enter into an agreement on the understanding that the properties should be sold to those with a local connection to the parishes listed on the agreement.

SCACKLETON

Action Group Meeting Report.

- No report as no meeting had taken place since the last Parish Council meeting.

Mobile Home update.

- Despite the Enforcement Notice stipulating the site be cleared and returned to its original state four alpacas had been brought to the site and a shelter erected.
- The structures need to be removed by 4th August 2019
- Ryedale District Councillor J. Bailey and Ryedale Planning Officer Alan Goforth had been notified of the situation.

HOVINGHAM.

Action Group Report. Circulated to Councillors. No questions raised.

Bus Timetable

- Coastliner will reduced the Hovingham service as from next week.
- North Yorkshire County Council or Coastliner under no obligation to conduct a public consultation.
- North Yorkshire County Council has agreed concessions be available to those using the 8.10 bus from Hovingham.
- Correspondence had been received from Ryedale Family History Group expressing concern about the loss of service and the effect on their users.
- Agreed to encourage as many people as possible to respond before the end of the month to the North Yorkshire County Council consultation on the re-tendering of the service.
- Emphasis was put on the need in both villages for a bus service to serve those residents who have no transport, internet facility or family nearby.
- Both communities have a large proportion of older residents who depend on the service.

Dog Waste bin near Hovingham Inn electric substation.

- Councillor R. Wainwright proposed, Councillor M. Wilson seconded and it was agreed to purchase a dog waste bin.
- Councillor R. Matthews requested a dog waste bin for Scackleton Lane and it was agreed in principle.
- Agenda item for the next meeting.

Electric Vehicle Charging Point installation proposed at Hovingham Village Hall.

- Councillor F. Colenso reported that the grant had been approved and the project was on track and they should know by the end of July whether the RDC Community Grant has been awarded.

Handrail to steps on York Hill.

- North Yorkshire County Council had surveyed the site and reported that the steps were not on a public right of way and have closed the case.
- Hovingham Estate had agreed repair the handrail.

Location of Armistice commemorative tree.

- The site has been agreed but still waiting for confirmation of the species and suitable protection.
- Clerk to organise plaques for both trees.

Hovingham Village Noticeboard.

- Clerk asked for more guidance on the type of noticeboard required as research had shown there is a variety of styles and sizes and prices.
- Councillor R. Matthews agreed to look at the current noticeboard.
- Chairman, Vice Chairman and Clerk to decide on the best approach.

RBL request for support to erect a flagpole with lighting at Hovingham Village Hall for Remembrance Weekend 2019.
