#### 1. INTERNMENT (EXCLUDING LABOUR, GRAVE DIGGING ETC)

a) Body or cremated remains of a still-born child or a child not over one month old	£20.00
b) Body, or cremated remains, of a child over one month and not over twelve years old	£50.00
c) Body of a person over the age of twelve years old	£150.00
d) Cremated remains of a person over the age of twelve years old	£75.00

## 2. EXCLUSIVE RIGHTS OF BURIAL IN EARTHEN GRAVE FOR A PERIOD NOT

## **EXCEEDING NINETY-NINE YEARS FROM THE DATE OF PURCHASE**

a) Grave 9ft by 4ft (2.27m by 1.22m) – single depth	£150.00
b) Grave 9ft by 4ft (2.27m by 1.22m) – double depth	£250.00
c) Grave 9ft by 9ft (2.27m by 2.27m) – single depth	£250.00
d) Grave 9ft by 9ft (2.27m by 2.27m) – double depth	£450.00
e) Grave 18 by 18 inches (0.45m) for cremated remains – single	£100.00
f) Grave 18 by 18 inches (0.45m) for cremated remains – double	£150.00

## 3. HEADSTONE FOR ALL PLOTS

a) Headstone	£50.00
b) To add an additional name	£30.00

## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

- Headstones should not exceed 2ft by 18in (60cm by 45cm) in size and wording on headstones should be appropriate. Curb stones should not be used.
- The aforesaid fees apply only where the person interred, or to be interred, or in respect of whom
  exclusive right of burial has deed purchase, is or was immediately before death an inhabitant of
  Hovingham or Scackleton, or in the case of a still-born child where one of the parents is such and
  inhabitant, in all other cases the fees will be double those specified above.
- In exchange of payment of the appropriate fee(s) the Parish Council will provide the plot for grave and/or headstone. The applicant is responsible for materials and labour, together with ensuring their safety and public liability.
- All work must be carried out to the standards and the satisfaction of the Parish Council, if in doubt contact the Parish Clerk for further details.
- All enquiries relating to the cemetery should, in the first instance, be addressed to the Parish Clerk.
