- Due to a previous booking at the village hall, we had to run on Thursday last week but luckily people still came including a few new ones who can't normally make a Wednesday.
- Our group has also inspired another mum to start up a group in Nawton on a Monday which has run for 2 weeks so far and is as successful as ours, which is fantastic for mum/dads/carers in the area.
- The most children we have had is 32 which is extremely full! An ideal number is 20-25.
- The book corner has been a roaring success and next week we are going to rearrange the hall to give this area a little more space as it is very popular when parents choose to have a quiet one 2 one moment with their child.
- We also do story time ever week and try to work to a theme and this has proved very engaging for the older children
 who are ready for pre-school and school. We get a core group who stay every week for this and we try to use props to
 get the children interacting.
- Our own fund raising has enabled us to reinvest in the kitchen area, which is always fully utilized, and is great for children using their imagination and developing role play ready for school. We have purchased sturdy equipment from an education provider similar to that used in preschool and early years.
- Our financial position is healthy which will provide a buffer if the numbers fall when the weather picks up.
- No further help is required from the Parish Council at this time and we thank you for your ongoing support to date.
