

Scackleton Action Group Report – July 2024

Last Action Group Meeting 23rd April, 2024 in Scackleton Church. Next meeting 23rd July, 2024.

Not had a meeting since the last report. Due to have it the evening before the Parish Council meeting. So only itemised a few new items.

Promoting a cleaner & healthier village

- Had a bit of confusion with Circle Garden Services with what was to be cut, when, but has since been sorted. A resident has also done some additional cutting of the verges alongside the stone walls to tidy things up before the cut at the end of June.
- The grass verges from the village down to Newstead Farm were cut by Chris Coverdale and have a 1 metre strip cut by the roadside. Hovingham Estate have cut the verges from Newstead to Hovingham Lodge.
- Dog fouling is still occurring. May have to put up a few more extra signs.

Community Events & Fund Raising

- Roland & Cynthia Firby organised 3 charity walks in Scackleton on Saturday 6th July, with Rosemary & Robert Sword hosting the afternoon tea & raffle. Donations of cakes and raffle prizes received. Approximately 25 people attended, with donations from people who could not come to the walk. They raised £406 for St George's Church and the Malton Food Bank.
- The Community Events Team are looking to put on a music event in Hovingham Village Hall in the Autumn – waiting on the band re dates, etc.
- Promoted many other events in /Hovingham over the last 2 months.

Hovingham & Scackleton Calendar

- The Action Group will use the £250 from the proceeds of the calendar to repair one of the village pumps.
