- Nicole will look into the cost of purchasing more "Neighbourhood watch" signs following concerns raised about a drone peering into people's houses.
- Wild Scackleton. Steve Britland is liaising with Nick Burrows re coming to the village to give a talk to residents. Awaiting dates & times. Manoir Farm & Highfield House are restoring / creating shallow ponds.
- A number of footpaths around the area are very overgrown or have been blocked off. Residents have been encouraged to photograph them to report, with GPS coordinates, to The National Landscape Howardian Hills to chase up the landowners.
