Promoting a cleaner & healthier village

- Had 3 grass cuts by Circle Garden Services. Chris Coverdale of Newstead Farm has kindly cut the grass down Scackleton Lane to the 90-degree bend.
- Dog fouling is still occurring on all lanes. Plenty of notices up.
- Wild Scackleton - Steve Britland is liaising with Nick Burrows re coming to the village to give a talk to residents. Steve is chasing up dates & times. Manor Farm & Highfield House are restoring / creating shallow ponds.
- Woodlands around Hovingham Lodge & Twaites Cottage – No indication when tree planting will occur around Thwaites Cottage. No news re what is happening with Lodge Farm. Tenant has been given notice.

Defibrillator & kiosk

- The kiosk awaiting the repair to the glass. Currently taped up to avoid more glass falling out. Person due to do the repair is recovering from car crash incident. No urgency.
