Neighbourhood Plan

- At the last meeting in October a couple of the members of the team unfortunately stood down due to other commitments. This meant that there was only 3 members left in the group. In light of this and the fact that funding has been pulled and a feeling that the Government is deprioritising NP's we took the reluctant decision to stop any work on this and re-assess if there are any changes in Government strategy.
- Whilst this is disappointing, the significant work involved and willingness of volunteers for something that we don't feel will make a difference has made it challenging. We will review with the PC to understand if there was still a desire to conduct a village survey/questionnaire and the value that this could create. We agreed to re-group on this in the springtime to discuss.
- There are costs of £176.99 that will need re-imbursing from the PC for the MIcrosoft 365 Licenses that have now been cancelled. (Giles)
